Pfizer vaccine available at Salsa Fest 2021

WADENA, Minn. – Sep. 07, 2021 – Tri-County Health Care is collaborating with Lakewood Health System to administer the COVID-19 vaccine at the Salsa Festival in Wadena on Sept. 18.

The Pfizer vaccine, which the FDA recently approved for ages 16-plus, will be administered by Tri-County staff from 12-7 p.m. Lakewood Health System will provide education on the vaccine and COVID-19.
